FWGA 2023 Pairings Guide

Tee Times

Play Golf Lexington requires all leagues to use tee times. The use of tee times by leagues helps to boost revenue earned by the city golf courses. Ample time is needed to fill tee times that have been reserved for a league but are not going to be used by the league.

USE THIS AS A RULE OF THUMB. If you think you might play **next week**, sign up at the beginning of your round **this week**. The Pairings Chair must release any unused tee times by noon on the Thursday prior to play. Your deadline for signing up is 11:00 a.m. on the Thursday before play.

How to Sign Up to Play

- **<u>Recommended</u>**: Golf Genius.
 - Go to the the FWGA website, www.fwga-lex.org.
 - Click on Weekly Sign Up & Winners.
 - Click on Sign Up using Golf Genius.
- <u>In a Pinch</u>: Having problems with Golf Genius, fill in the form on the Weekly Sign Up & Winners page of the FWGA website and click the Send Form button (Note: This makes extra work for the Pairings Chair, so please use Golf Genius if possible; if you have never used Golf Genius to sign up, please ask for help).

What You'll See

- A confirmation email. The email from Golf Genius should be immediate; the email from the Pairings Chair may take more time. If you don't get one from Golf Genius, it may have been diverted to your spam folder. Look there and add noreply@golfgenius.com to your list of contacts. If you cannot find it, you've haven't signed up. Try again.
- A notification email on Thursday. It will notify you of your tentative tee for Tuesday's play.
- A notification email/text on Monday evening. It will give you your tee time for Monday and will be as close to your tentative tee time as possible. Tee Times could shift due to cancelations.
- A text on Tuesday morning. A text will be sent to you with your GGID, your playing partners, and the Pairings Chair's cell phone number.

Recording Your Round

- **Golf Genius app**. Keep score electronically with the Golf Genius App. Start by entering your GGID. Enter your hole-by-hole scores and view the scores of other golfers on the course. (**Do not** post your scores to GHIN from Golf Genius; the Pairings Chair will post everyone's score to GHIN after scores have been tabulated and the winners are identified.)
- Scorecard. Use a paper scorecard to record the scores for your group. Attest to your round by signing the scorecard **after** you have verified your hole-by-hole scores. Remember, you are attesting to the hole scores; addition errors are not penalized, but incorrect hole scores are.
- **Chip-in Pot.** If you are in the Chip-In Pot, clearly indicate any chip-ins, listing Golfer and Hole Number, on your scorecard.
- Text Your Scorecard. *Immediately* at the end of your round, text a legible copy of your group's scorecard to the Pairings Chair, showing all hole-by-hole scores and all signatures. The Pairings Chair's cell phone number is 859-979-1319. DO NOT TEXT SCORECARD PICTURES TO THE NUMBER THAT SENDS YOU THE GGID. They will not be received by the Pairings Chair.
